Supplies provided by the library:

7 craft sticks

5 rubber bands

Plastic spoon

Marshmallows

toothpicks

Collect items from around your home to decorate your catapult!
None of these items are required, but suggestions of what you could use!

You could use...

Markers/crayons/paint

Stickers

Glitter

Paper



Step-by-step Instructions:

STEP 1: Color and decorate the 7 craft sticks

STEP 2: Place 5 crafts sticks one on top of the other and secure the ends with rubber bands

STEP 3: Secure the remaining two craft sticks together with a rubber band only on one end creating a V shape

STEP 4: Slide the 5 connected craft sticks into the opening of the V shape

STEP 5: Secure the two piles together by crisscrossing 2 rubber bands around the middle

STEP 6: Attach your spoon to the top popsicle stick using a rubber band

STEP 7: Using the toothpicks and marshmallows, build your own marshmallow castle!

step 8: Pretend to be a knight attacking the marshmallow castle to save your kingdom. Use marshmallows to shoot at the castle you made. See if your catapult can knock the castle down or if your castle is too strong to knock out!
