Dragon Eyeball Necklace

Supplies provided by the library:

- clear cabochons (glass eyes)
- metal pendant frames
- black necklace cord
- black / metallic markers
- paper circles
- glue dots



Step-by-Step Instructions:

Step 1: Use the black marker to draw an oval eyeball or a round eyeball in the center of your glass cabochon (use rounded side of cabochon, not flat side)

Step 2: Decorate around the center eyeball using a metallic marker (ex: outline the black eyeball, draw dots, slash marks, whatever you want)

Step 3: Wait for marker to dry completely!

Step 4: Flip the dry cabochon over to the flat side and use a glue dot to stick the paper circle to the cabochon.

Step 5: Place a glue dot on the flat side of the cabochon and insert into metal pendant frame.

Step 6: Slide onto black necklace cord.

Your dragon eyeball necklace looks amazing!
