Dragon Flame Blower Craft

Supplies provided by the library:

- 4 pom poms
- 2 plastic eyes
- green construction paper
- red / yellow / orange streamers
- glue dots

Items to collect from around your home:

- cardboard toilet paper roll

(a paper towel tube cut in half or a small paper/styrofoam cup will also work)

(Parents: cut a medium hold in the bottom of the paper/styrofoam cup if using this item so your child can blow through the hole)

Step-by-Step Instructions:

Step 1: Wrap green construction paper square around toilet paper tube and secure with glue dots (overlap construction paper slightly to hide glue dots)

Step 2: Attach one end of the red/yellow/orange streamers to inside of tube on one end using glue dots

Step 3: Attach one plastic eye to each of two pom poms and secure pom poms to one end of tube with glue dots (opposite end of the streamers)

Step 4: Attach two remaining pom poms above the streamers end (the nostrils of the dragon)

Step 5: Blow on the non-streamer end and watch the streamers flare out like flames!
